COVID-19 CONTACT TRACING STUDENT DECISION TREE FOR AT SCHOOL

For students who are a close contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19.

A close contact is a person who was within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes of someone who is infected.

Fully Vaccinated OR Had COVID-19 in the Last 90 Days: MASKED/UNMASKED EXPOSURE

If asymptomatic:

 No need to quarantine, just symptom monitor

If symptomatic:

- Stay home in isolation for at least 10 days from time symptoms started until symptoms improved
- Must be fever/ symptom free for 24 hours without any fever reducing medications
- May seek evaluation and/or COVID-19 test, if desired

Partially Vaccinated OR Not Vaccinated: MASKED/UNMASKED EXPOSURE

*Either one or both parties were NOT wearing a mask and in close contact

If asymptomatic:

- Stay home from all activities for at least 10 days since last contact with the positive case.
- If the person receives a negative test result after day 5 from exposure then quarantine can end after day 7 from exposure. *These tests are not offered by the school. Parents who wish to pursue testing for their child must have a test done by a medical professional and submit it to their school site office.
- Siblings and household contacts DO NOT need to stay home or quarantine

If symptomatic OR positive test is received:

- Stay at home in isolation for at least 10 days from the time symptoms started until symptoms improved AND no fever for 24 hours (without fever reducing medications)
- Siblings and household contacts stay home and quarantine from all actives for at least 10 days
