



Inspire Science Online “How To’s”

1. Use Clever to login and get to the Inspire Science website. Click McGraw Hill button




2. Once you get to the McGraw Hill site, click “Launch” under the Inspire icon


3. All assignments can be found by using the “To-Do” button (upper right hand corner, dark orange text) or under your calendar.



4. Make sure that you do all assignments if there are multiple pages of assignments




Double check that all parts of an assignment are completed before submitting (there are often multiple slides in an assignment). This assignment has 3 parts, for example.




Optional Tools: Highlighter, Note Tool, and Read aloud


1. Use cursor to select the text that you either want to highlight, make a note about, and/or read aloud.
2. Once you select the text you will see a tool bar giving you many options:



3. You can access any of the notes you made by clicking the “table of contents” icon



4. You can also export to download any of the notes/highlights you made (which you might want to use for recording evidence). Exporting and downloading seems to be the only way that you can access your notes/highlights when you are doing different assignments (example collecting/recording evidence)



5. Of course you do not have to use these tools – you can always write your own notes by hand, but I do suggest that you write notes of some kind as you read, because when you go to write down your evidence and reasoning/summary/conclusion, you will not have access to the text portion.
